The format of an outline of rhetorical analysis essay:

The format that needs to be followed for the outline is mentioned below:

Introduction

The purpose of writing multiple sentences is that in the final draft the writer can choose or merge these sentences to make one impactful sentence. Hence in the outline, the writer should try to focus on the important aspects of the source such as how the author tries to grab the attention of the readers. Once this is done the [online essay writer](#) has to provide a thesis statement in which they have to write the main purpose of writing a rhetorical analysis essay on this particular source. Trying multiple thesis statements in the outline will enable the writer to produce one effective statement for the essay.

Body paragraphs

There are several body paragraphs in this essay and each of them addresses a separate thing. In this section of the outline, the writer has to discuss the strategies used by the author of the source to attract maximum readers. For each of the strategies the writer also has to provide support in the form of evidence from other credible sources. State the sources in the outline so that the writer already has a reference for the final draft.

Conclusion

This is the last section of the outline in which the writer first briefly summarizes the main points of the outline and then gives the concluding remarks regarding the work done by the author of the source.
